Digital storytelling at its most basic core is the practice of using computer-based tools to tell stories and can be used in education in many ways. One of the first decisions to be made when deciding to use this tool in the curriculum is whether a teacher will create the Digital Stories or have their students do it. Some teachers may decide to create

their own stories and to use them as a way to present new material. An engaging, multimedia-rich digital story can serve as an anticipatory set or hook to capture the attention of diverse learners and increase their interest in exploring new ideas.

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
